Excerpts from the Minutes of the Regular Session conducted via video conferencing of the Sangguniang Panlungsod on Wednesday, March 2, 2022

ORDINANCE NO. 1010

AN ORDINANCE RECLASSIFYING LOT NOS. 1932, 1934 AND 1933-B, ALL SITUATED AT BARANGAY AYUDANTE, CANDON CITY, ILOCOS SUR FROM AGRICULTURAL USE TO RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCIAL USE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Candon, Province of Ilocos Sur in regular session assembled:

Section 1. Reclassification of Lot. Lot Nos. 1932, 1934 and 1933-B situated at Barangay Ayudante, Candon City, Ilocos Sur with a total area of **Twelve Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-five square meters (12,325 sq. m.)**, more or less, are hereby reclassified as follows:

Section 2. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any provision of this ordinance is declared not valid by any Court of competent jurisdiction or revoked/suspended by the authorities concerned, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions which shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 4. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
