ORDINANCE NO. 950

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 905, ENTITLED:
AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLES
ADVISORY COUNCIL IN THE CITY OF CANDON

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of
Candon, Province of Ilocos Sur in regular session assembled:

SECTION 1. Amendments. Ordinance No. 905, entitled: "An Ordinance
creating the Indigenous Peoples Advisory Council in the City of Candon" is
hereby amended as follows:

A. Two new sections are hereby inserted as follows:

SECTION 1. Short Title. This ordinance shall be known as
the "CANDON CITY INDIGENOUS PEOPLES ADVISORY
COUNCIL ORDINANCE".

SECTION 3. Objectives. The following are the objectives of
the IP Advisory Council:

- a. The Council shall formulate programs and policies for the welfare
of IP in the city which shall be forwarded to the Office of City
Mayor, the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, non-government
agencies and institutions and other concerned agencies;
- b. The Council shall, from time to time, coordinate with the Tribal
Chieftains and other indigenous peoples organizations and
federations to constantly monitor the problems being encountered
by the IP communities;
- c. The Council shall coordinate with the government as well as private
agencies to solicit support in the implementation of projects and
programs for the IPs in the city;
- d. The Council shall encourage the participation of the indigenous
peoples in all levels of decision-making on matters that affect their
rights, lives and destinies;
- e. The Council shall formulate plans and programs with the end in
view of transforming the IPs to be an independent, educated and
self-reliant sector of the community while preserving their unique
culture and tradition; and
- f. The Council shall assist the City Government in the issuance of
Executive Orders, enactment of ordinances and approval of
resolutions pertaining to IPs welfare and concerns.
